The Persons listed above notify the Court of a dispute and request that this dispute be transferred to the Confederated Tribes of Coos, Lower Umpqua and Siuslaw Indians Tribal Court Peacegiving program. A summary of the dispute is attached as Exhibit A.

The Tribal Peacegiving Ordinance at CLUSITC 2-14-7(a) says that: "With the consent of the all parties or the child in a Child in Need of Supervision or Juvenile Offender matter, the Tribal Court may transfer any case or dispute to the Peacegiving Court."

By signing below, each party acknowledges that all of the parties to this dispute meet one or more of the following criteria:

- Tribal Member of Coos, Lower Umpqua or Siuslaw Indians (CLUSI);
- Spouse or Domestic Partner of a CLUSI Tribal member
- CLUSI or tribal entity employee
- A resident of the CLUSI reservation.

A parent or guardian must sign for any party under the age of 18. Parents of a minor child may receive notice of, and attend any Peacegiving proceeding.
