Work experience

In 2015 with Blue Earth Federal Board approval, I launched a startup for the Tribe initially named Comlink, then renamed Blue Earth Services and Technologies. I developed this business within the CTCLUSI established business structure, IRA Section 17 Corporation established and enacted by Congress in 2000. During this experience I successfully obtained an 8(a) Certification through the US Small Business Administration for the Tribe's Blue Earth Enterprise. In addition, I initiated all qualification to acquire HUBZone affiliation. Through my education and training I have certifications in Managing and Writing Federal Proposals, certified member of Native American GAP Cost Accounting Federal Contracts and Business Management coursework. I have a firm understanding of Tribal governance and Tribal negotiations. I possess the ability and willingness to work collaboratively with a broad range of groups such as Small Business Administration, Bureau of Indian Affairs and numerous Contracting Officers as well as Oregon Tribal Economic Development officers. I appreciate a strategic plan that streamlines our Tribes multitude of project with the least number of barriers for success.

I served on the Steering Committee for Tribal Business Incubator for CTCLUSI. In which we assisted Tribal Members in the principles of business

structure and the creation of starting small business. My family is an important aspect of my daily life, while not focusing on building the Tribe's enterprises, I was also coaching multiple youth sports for my son.

Our Tribe has made notable accomplishments since restoration, and it is my promise to participate in continuous improvements and facilitate new prospects for the good of the Tribe.

- Expanded Health Services to all Tribal Families
- Promotion of Family gatherings to include; camp outs, outdoor activities and hunting/fishing gatherings with emphasis on our tribal culture and customs.

- Equal opportunity housing for Tribal membership, not dependent upon their income.
